Mission:

The mission of Husky Wrestling Booster Club is to provide the Horizon High School Wrestling Program with volunteer and financial support to further player and team development

Involvement or the lack thereof in the Husky Wrestling Booster Club will not affect the composition of the teams, nor any wrestler's playing time or standing on the team. Such issues are not within the boundaries of this parent group.

Membership:

Any parent of a wrestler or potential team member may join Husky Wrestling Booster Club. For insurance liability purposes, it is a requirement that all members participating in the activities of Husky Wrestling Booster Club also be members of PAWS (Horizon High School Club).

Officers:*

The following officers (groups) will govern the parent group:

*Secretary/Treasurer

Booster Club Representative(s):

Varsity Team Representative

Persons may hold more than one office except those designated by*.

(i.e.: President can not also be Treasurer but can be President and JV Representative)

Only parents/guardians of a current team member may be an officer of Husky Wrestling Booster Club. If a parent/guardian chooses not to continue as an officer or is not eligible to remain an officer, the President shall appoint an eligible person to the position. A vote of the remaining officers and members shall follow as soon as possible in accordance to club voting guidelines. Officers shall be elected annually by the present members. New officers are nominated by past officers.

If the President is unavailable, then the Secretary/Treasurer shall do so with the vote to follow. Term of Office will be from date of last payment for end-of-year banquet, or March 1, whichever is later; until February 28, or one year from date of last payment, whichever is later.

Meetings:

Husky Wrestling Booster Club officer and members will meet periodically as deemed necessary but not less than once per quarter.

Accounting:

All funds raised by Husky Wrestling Booster Club shall be held in a bank account for the sole benefit of Husky Wrestling Booster Club Parent Group in support of the Horizon High School Wrestling program. Checks over \$250.00 will require signatures of both the President and the Treasurer. Payment request vouchers will be submitted for each purchase to the Treasurer for approval before purchase. Reimbursement will not be guaranteed unless these procedures are followed.

Unused funds at the end of the fiscal year will be considered general funds and will be carried over to the next year.

Proper accounting methods and sufficient audit trail must be maintained for all activities. Detailed Monthly statements must be submitted to PAWS CFO before the 20th of each month. Financial records will be provided at each quarterly meeting and subject to inspection by the President and officers with notice.

Voting:

All matters, financial or otherwise, affecting Husky Wrestling Booster Club shall be decided by a majority vote of the officers including amounts and general usage of funds. At least 2/3 of the officers are required to be present for voting. Officers shall be elected annually by the present members. New officers are nominated by past officers.

Dissolution:

In the event that Husky Wrestling Booster Club disbands, all funds left in the bank account will be donated to Horizon High School Wrestling Program school account.
